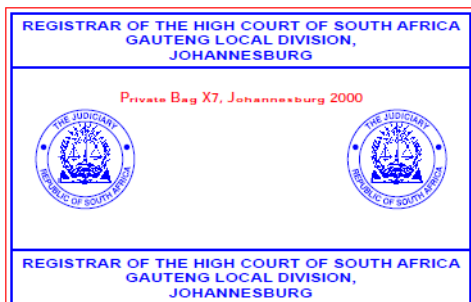

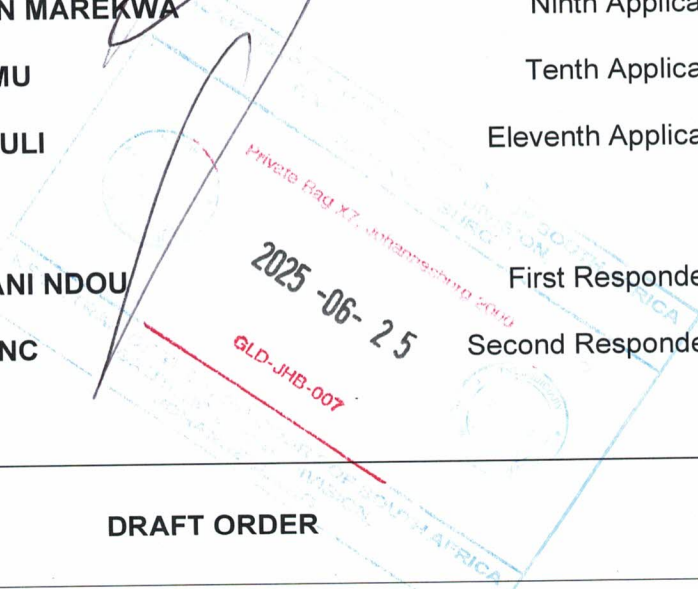


DRAFT ORDER

HAVING READ THE PAPERS, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AS FOLLOWS:

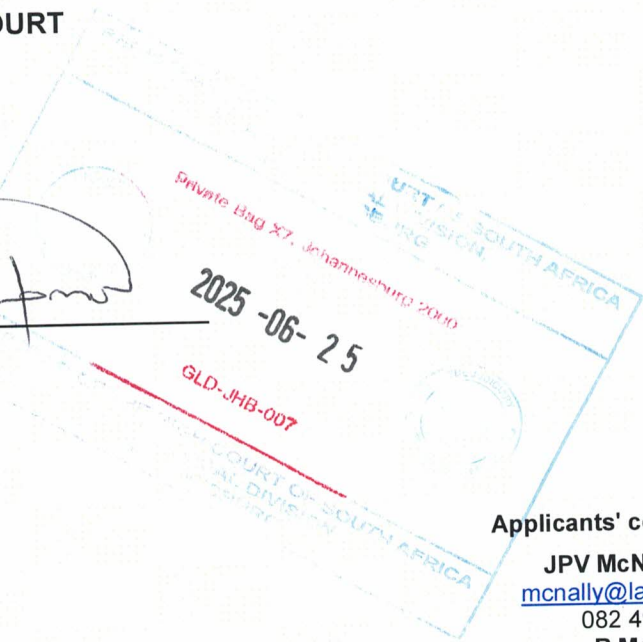
